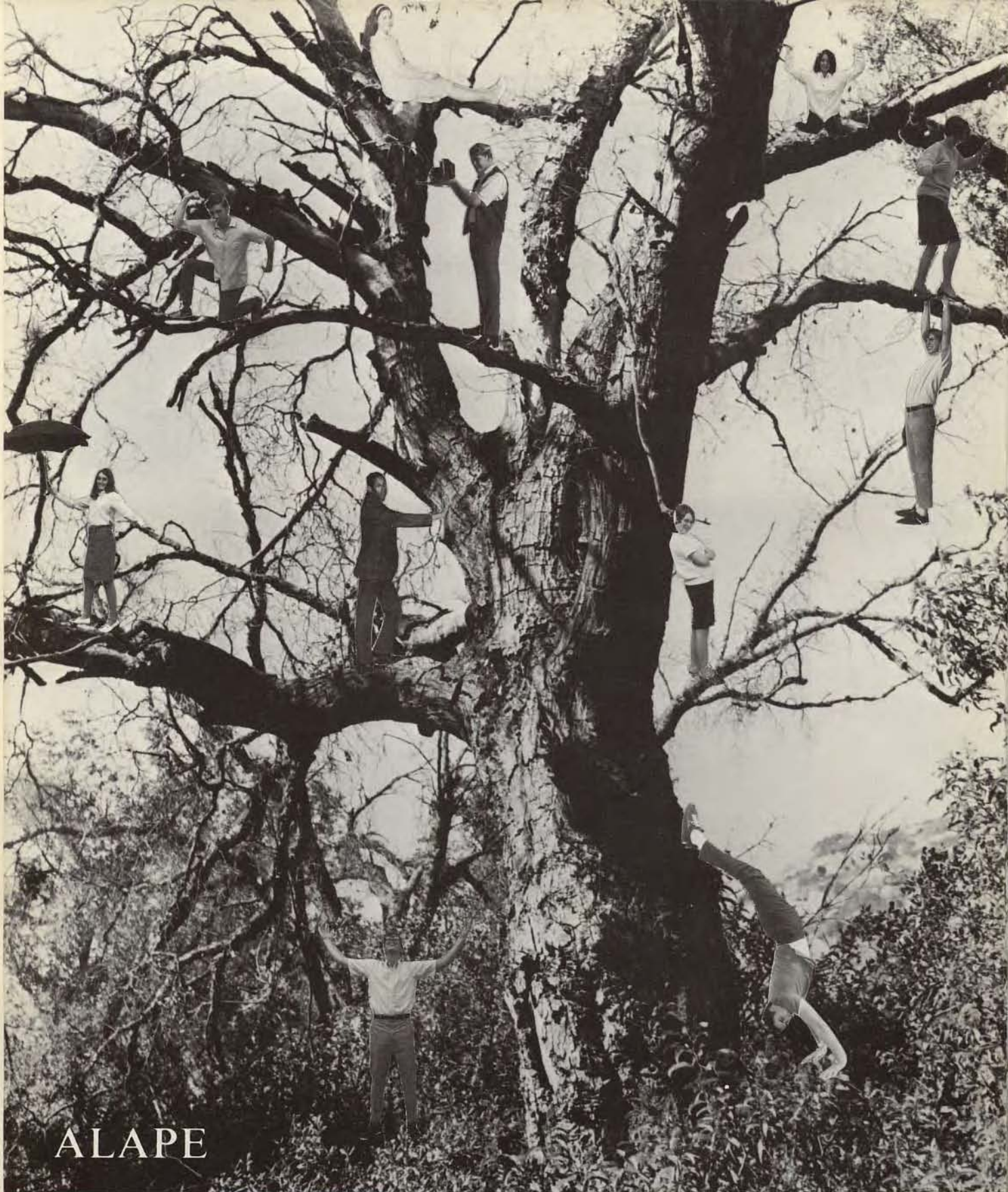
On March 16 and 17, our campus was flooded by hoardes of alumni, who eagerly entered into the vari-ous games of the day.
