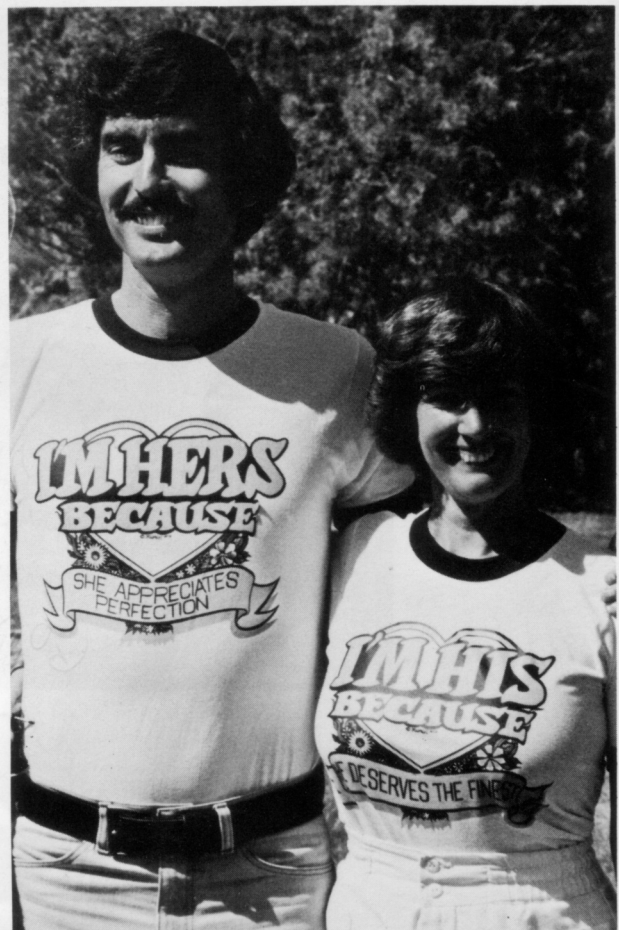
DEDICATION

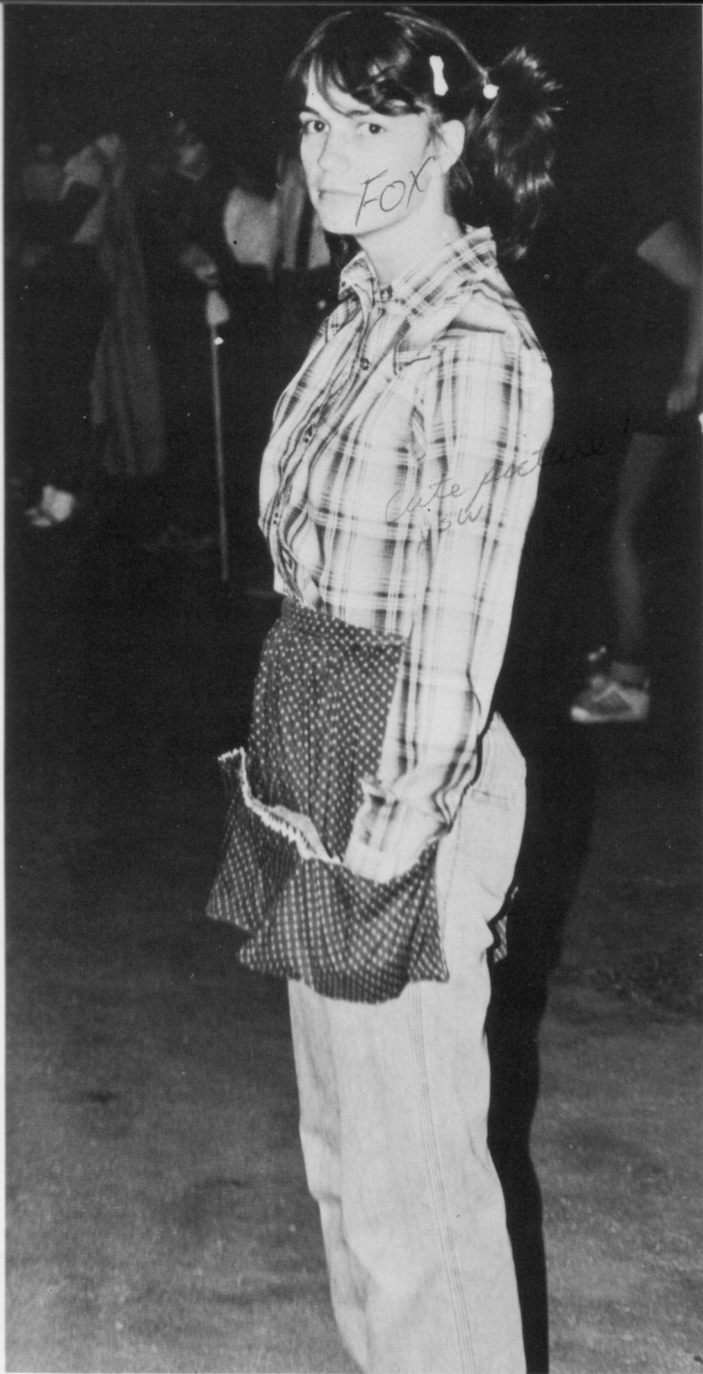

LARRY BOYER

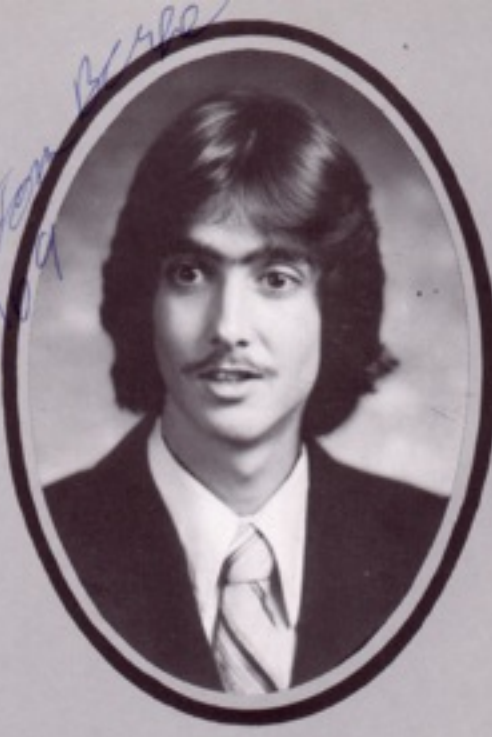

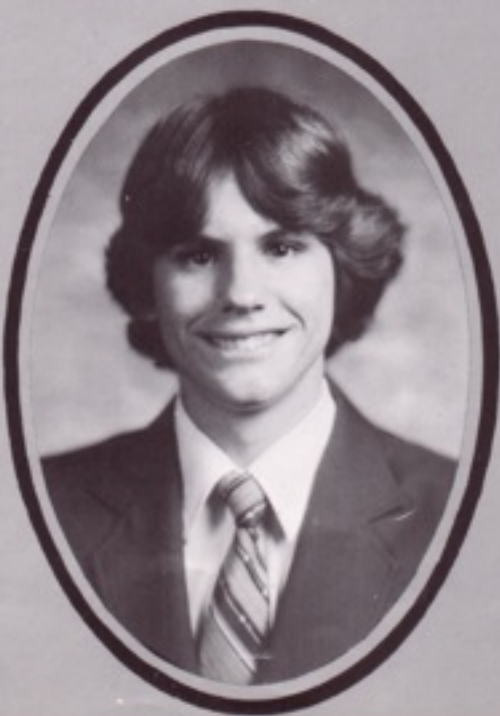
MELINDA LAM

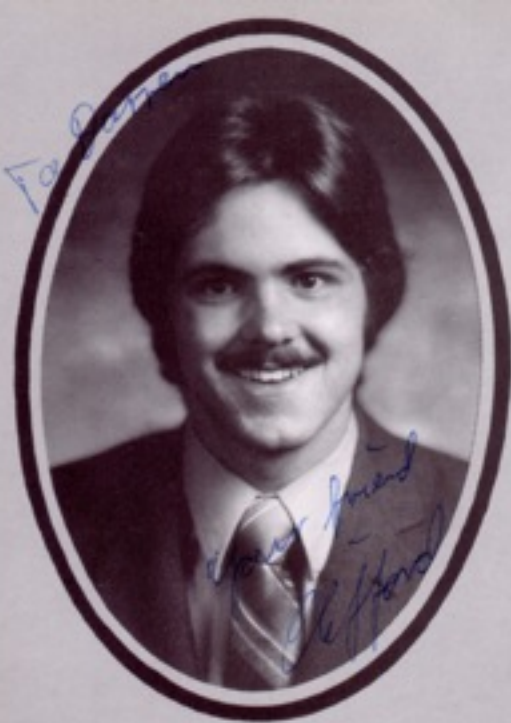
LYDIA TELLEZ

SHAN WORK

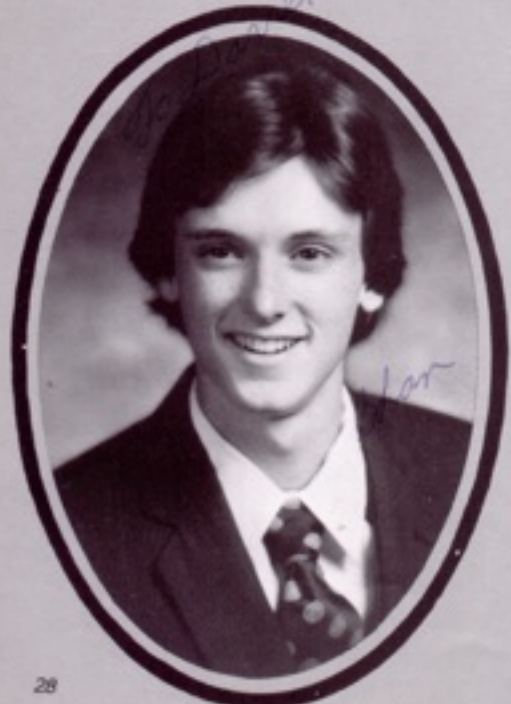
